The following stallions have generously had breedings donated to the NWSHBA by their owners. For complete information on any extra costs associated with breeding to each stallion, contact the stallion owner before placing your bid. Booking fees, deposits for shipping, collecting, containers, veterinary and mare care are all usually required by stallion owners prior to breeding your mare. These fees are responsibility of the mare owner. Please familiarize yourself with the terms and conditions of the stallion owner's contract before you bid. Remember, you are bidding on the right to enter in a breeding contract with each individual owner.

The auction shall be governed by the following terms and conditions:

- The 2007 stallion service auction will be conducted by first offering an Instant bid, those not sold on instant bid by January 15th shall be auctioned in the sealed bidding.
- The minimum bid will be ½ the stallion's normal stud fee (without the booking fee included as in most cases booking fees are due directly to stallion owner).
- **Bidding opens January 15 and closes March 15, 2007**, bids must be postmarked by that date and received by March 25th, 2007 in order to be accepted. Any stallions not bid on at that time shall be placed in a second chance auction running from March 31st to May 1st, 2007. At this time the Auction shall be closed
- The stallion services offered in this auction are intended for the 2007 breeding season only.
- Bids will be accepted on the attached form only (or photocopy). ONLY ONE BID PER FORM. A bidder may bid on any number stallion services.
- Along with the bid form, the bidder must include a separate check in the proper amount, made out to the Northwest Sport Horse Breeders Association, for each bid submitted. Write each stallion's name on the appropriate check.
- Checks of winning bids will not be cashed until the bidder is notified. Checks of unsuccessful bidders will be returned promptly after results are known. Once won you can make payment on paypal at our website.
- Checks returned for insufficient funds will invalidate the bid, and the second place bid shall be declared the winning bid.
- In case of tie bids for any stallion service, the bid with the earliest postmark will be the winner.
- Bids are binding and cannot be withdrawn after March 1, 2007 (April 25, 2007 for second chance bidding). After that time, the winning bidder will be obligated to NWSHBA for the amount of the bid whether or not the stallion service is used by the mare owner. Refunds will be made only in cases where the stallion dies or becomes unfit for service prior to servicing the mare. Failure of a mare to conceive or carry a foal to term does not constitute grounds for refund.

The winning bidder agrees to abide by the terms of the stallion owner's breeding contract, and the Northwest Sport Horse Breeders Association does not assume liability for any disputes that may arise between bidder and stallion owner.
